Killeen, Texas is located in Bell County about halfway between Austin and Waco and lies between two US Army Corps of Engineers lake (Belton and Stillhouse Hollow). The lakes provide the usual freshwater activities.

Killeen, in the November 2022 issue of US News and World Report, was ranked the 5th best city to live in Texas.

Killeen is located adjacent to Fort Hood which maintains a 215,000 acre reservation. Much of the land is available to the public for hunting and fishing after obtaining the proper permits and licenses.

Mother Neff State Park is a short drive to the north offering camping, hiking and educational programs throughout the year.


Closer to home is the Miller Springs Nature Area on Lake Belton and Chalk Ridge Falls Park on Stillhouse Lake.

The Mayborn Science Theatre is an iMax theatre featuring scientific showing for all ages.

There are numerous city parks (with water park and rock climbing wall) as well as golfing, bowling and skating.

"Vive Les Arts" is a local theater group putting on live plays throughout the year.
