



Southside Food Pantry – Frequently Asked Questions

1. **What is the Southside Food Pantry (SFP)?**
 - a. The SFP is a faith-based, not for profit outreach effort of the Southside Church of Christ located at 1505 Trimmier Road, Killeen, Texas providing groceries to those who find themselves in the unfortunate situation of needing them.
2. **Where is the Southside Food Pantry?**
 - a. The SFP and the distribution area is located on the North side of the church building at 1505 Trimmier Road, Killeen.
3. **What are the hours of operation?**
 - a. The SFP is normally open on Tuesdays 9:00 am – 11:00 am and Saturdays 9:00 am – 11:00 am.
4. **How often can a family come to the pantry?**
 - a. Families may come to the pantry two (2) times each month.
5. **Who is eligible to receive food?**
 - a. During this time of Covid response, paperwork to receive groceries has been significantly reduced; anyone who feels they are in need is eligible.
6. **Do you provide clothing, gas vouchers, or other services?**
 - a. Unfortunately, limited space prevents us from being able to distribute items other than groceries except on pre-announced occasions.
7. **How can I ask a food pantry related question that is not addressed here?**

8. **How is the Southside Pantry funded and where does it get the foods?**
 - a. The SFP receives funding as a budgeted part of the Southside Church of Christ, from cash and non-perishable grocery items from individuals, from Food For Families, from grocery donations from HEB, other local charitable organizations.
9. **How can I help the Southside Food Pantry?**
 - a. Members of the Southside church can volunteer their time
 - i. Monday food pickup at the Food Care Center 7:30 am
 - ii. Monday food stocking at the SFP 8:30 am – 11:00 am
 - iii. Tuesday food pickup at HEB 7:30 am
 - iv. Tuesday food distribution at SFP 9:00 am – 11:00 am
 - v. Saturday food pickup at HEB 7:30 am
 - vi. Saturday food distribution at SFP 9:00 am – 11:00 am
 - b. Cash Donations are always helpful; designate the donation to the Food Pantry
 - c. Often there are supplies the pantry needs (egg cartons, bags, gloves, masks)
